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HOW THE COMPETITION WILL WORK

The event will be held in the same way in 2007 as it was in 2006. We will hold a heats process, which means that every band that enters the Dux-de-Lux RounDUp 2007 will have a chance to be heard and judged, which means the best bands will go through to the next stage.

Instrument Backline

Dux-de-Lux RounDUp 2007 will provide the following instrument backline at every event; 2 x Quad Guitar Cabinets, 1 x Bass Cabinet and Bass Amplifier, 1 x Keyboard Stand, 1 x Basic 5 Piece Drum kit (you will need to bring your own cymbals, snare, sticks and special accessories such as extra cymbal or tom stands). You will need to bring the rest.

The Heats

Every band that enters will perform one song at the heats. The heats are being held on the 8th and 9th of September in the Dux-de-Lux Tavern Bar from (approx) 10am till 6pm each day. Each band has been allocated 10 minutes to perform their song including set up time so don't be late. It would be best to be at the heats 20 minutes before your slot in case any bands don't turn up etc. You will be contacted on Monday September the 3rd and given a performance time. If the time given really, really, really doesn't suit your band then we will do our best to arrange another time for you, but it is your bands responsibility to be there with all your gear in time to set up and play. If you're late or just don't turn up you will not get to go any further in the competition. The 16 best bands as judged will be chosen from the heats process and will go on to the quarter-finals. The 16 bands will be contacted as soon as possible (the next day if possible) after the heats. The remaining bands that have not made it through will be contacted within the week following the heats.

The Quarter-Finals

There are four quarter-finals that will be held Friday and Saturday nights at The Dux-de-Lux on the 14th, 15th, 21st and 22nd of September and the 16 bands that are through to the quarter-finals will be told which of the four nights they will be playing. Four bands will compete at each quarter-final. Each band will have strictly 15 minutes to set up and 30 minutes to perform. The band that the judges decide is the winner on each of the four quarter-final nights will go through to the Grand Final.

The Grand Final

The four winning bands from each quarter-final will all perform at the Grand Final that is to be held Saturday night, September the 29th at the Dux-de-Lux. Each band will have strictly 15 minutes to set up and 30 minutes to perform. The band that the judges decide is the best on the night will win the title of Winners of Dux-de-Lux RounDUp 2007 and the swag of prizes that come with it.

ENTRY CRITERIA

By submitting your entry to the Dux-de-Lux RounDUp 2007 you have agreed to abide by the following criteria;

- If you win Dux-de-Lux RounDUp 2007 you must be available for the prize pack that is being put together by RDU and the Dux-de-Lux. An inability to meet these arrangements will result in forfeit the prize, which can then be offered to any other finalist.
 - As a contestant in Dux-de-Lux RounDUp 2007 you must be open to the possibility of interviews on RDU98.5FM and other media during or after the event.
 - RDU98.5FM and Dux-de-Lux must be acknowledged on all promotional material following the final.
 - RDU will do its best to facilitate any matters between the prize winners and the prize sponsors. Bands are required to agree to the conditions of the prize sponsors, such as time limits and logo placements.
 - No decisions made by the judges will be entered into with the judges or RDU98.5FM after the competition.
- Be hard. Take it like a man... or woman. No band competition is perfect, it's all just opinion.
